

BR White Double Arrows

Full size/application details are provided below.

Whilst there are probably a few unique examples of alternative applications to those detailed below, the following list can be taken as far as Fox Transfers are aware, as being an accurate breakdown of the double arrow scene to date. - 16mm width: Class 87 Prototype InterCity Executive
- 15.25mm width: Class 31 Original Railfreight Grey
 - Class 37 Revised Standard Blue
 - Class 37 Original Railfreight Grey
 - Class 26 Original Railfreight Grey
 - Class 20 Original Railfreight Grey
- 12.25mm width: Class 47 Original Railfreight Grey, Red stripe
 - Class 73 InterCity Executive
 - Class 56 Original Railfreight Grey, Red stripe
 - Class 31 Original Railfreight Grey, Red stripe
 - Class 37 Original Railfreight Grey, Red stripe
- 6mm width: Class 47 InterCity Executive
 - Class 47 ScotRail
- 5mm width: All classes, Standard Blue Livery
- 4.25mm width: dependent on specific loco rather than class. 4.25mm width is also principal size for multiple units and coaching stock eg DBSOs

F2300 Double arrow motifs in white

- 4.25mm wide: 5 pairs
- 5mm wide: 7 pairs
- 6mm wide: 6 pairs
- 12.25mm wide: 4 pairs
- 15.25mm wide: 2 pairs
- 16mm wide: 1 pair
- 17mm wide: 1 pair
- 17.75mm wide: 1 pair
